POSITION OVERVIEW

This person has the opportunity to work as part of the British Triathlon web development team to help maintain and improve the various internal and external websites that we administer. The person should have knowledge of the "full stack" of web development whilst using PHP as the back-end language. They should be able to work collaboratively with other members of the web development team but also be able to problem solve and successfully deliver projects entirely independently. They should be able to liaise with project owners and the Web Development Manager through all stages of project delivery to ensure effective communication between teams.

MAIN TASKS & RESPONSIBILITIES

- To work on and deliver web development projects promptly to maintain and improve our various internal and external websites, making sure written code is clear, efficient, accessible and secure.
- To use issue and project tracking software and amend and carry out bug fixes and change requests on our websites as required
- To conduct code reviews and quality assurance on colleagues' work to ensure code is secure and consistent and to make sure the work you submit for code review follows the same standards and conventions
- To engage with the project delivery process: working either as the sole web developer or as part of a wider team, assisting with or leading on project scoping, regular project meetings, solution proposals, estimating timescales and feeding back regularly to the Web Development Manager
- To share innovative technology ideas and development techniques to improve the quality of our web solutions and the effectiveness of our team
- To assist with maintaining our hosting solutions and payment gateways when required
- To occasionally provide day-to-day support for all computer hardware and software problems when required.
