



## Competitor Appeal Form

Extract from British Triathlon Rules

### **30 APPEALS**

- 30.1 An appeal is a request for a review of a decision made by an official
- 30.2 Appeals cannot be made against “judgement calls” by officials. Judgement calls include, **but are not limited to:** drafting, dangerous riding and unsporting conduct.
- 30.3 Appeals must be made in writing to the race official within 15 minutes of the penalty being posted and be accompanied by a **fee of £15.00**, made payable to British Triathlon if paying by cheque, refundable if the appeal is upheld.
