- British Triathlon Competition Rules

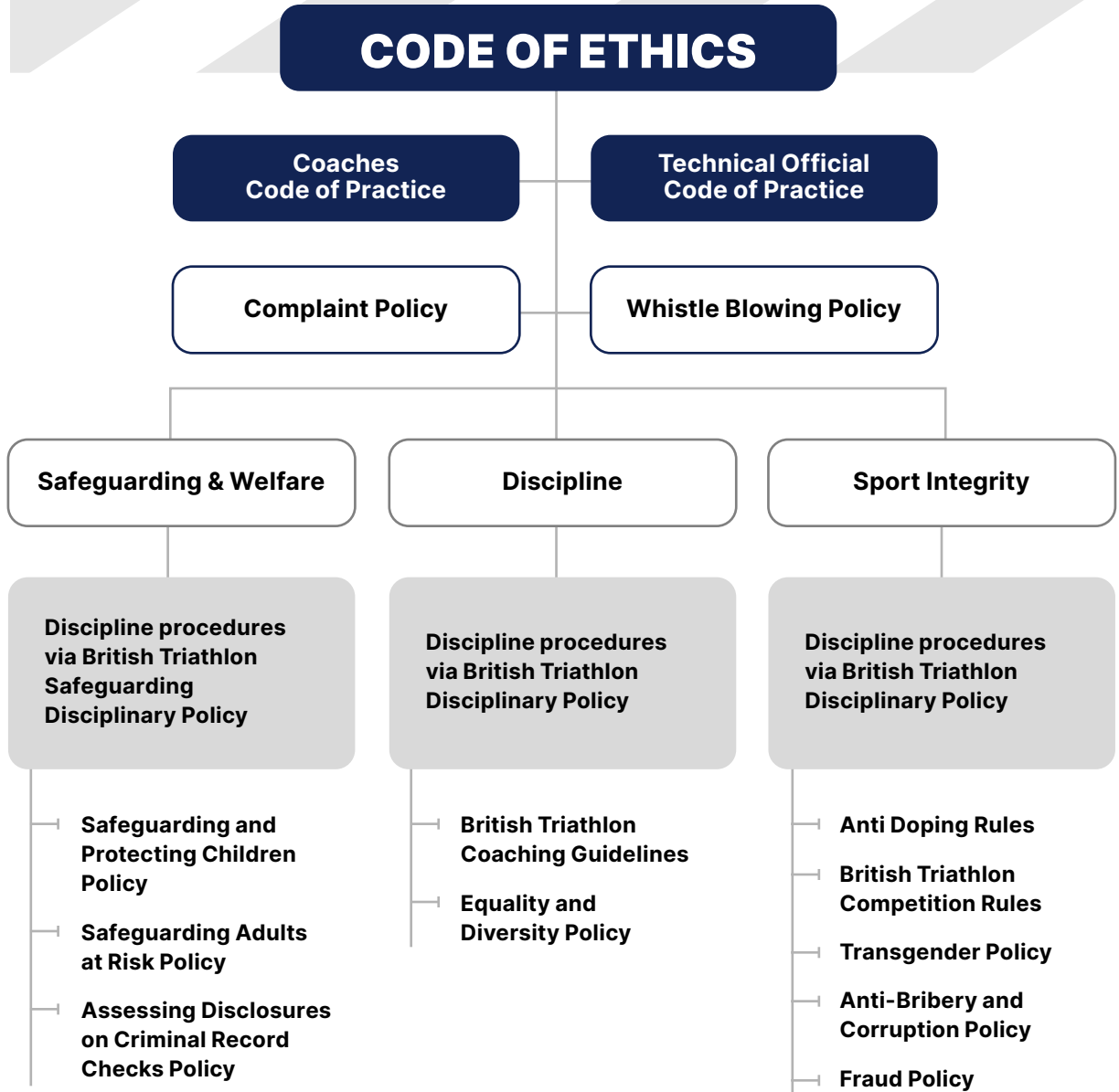
